Students must pass a minimum of four (4) units of English to fulfill graduation requirements. Courses are designated with a Roman Numeral (I. II. III. IV.) and are sequential. We also offer Stories of Suspense, Journalism/Writing, Classical Mythology and a MCAS ELA preparatory class.

The staff at Salem Prep, accommodate the various different learning styles of the students by using a variety of teaching techniques such as differentiating instruction.
